

OneRen and Creative Scotland: Visual Artists and Craft Makers Award (VACMA)

VACMA Renfrewshire offers small grants to visual artists and craft makers for their creative development at all stages of their career.

The VACMA scheme offers two levels of bursaries:

- 1. Bursaries of £750
- 2. Early-career bursaries of £500

The fund is open to visual artists and craft makers who can demonstrate a commitment to developing their creative practice and who are living or working or maintaining a studio space within the Local Authority area to which they are applying.
